# GENERATOR SAFETY & USAGE

#### Take Care • Be Cautious





- Store under cover to prolong life of generator.
- Cover with sheet/blanket to prevent insect nesting.
- Drain fuel tank & carby for extended storage periods.



### FUEL

- Confirm generator fuel type (diesel/petrol) before fueling.
- · Always use clean, fresh fuel. Do not overfill.
- Top up regularly. Turn generator off to refuel.
- Allow generator to cool down before refuelling.
- Drain fuel tank & carby for extended storage periods.



## MAINTENANCE

- Perform service at regular intervals (ie. every 20 hours).
- Service includes fuel & oil filter change; air filter clean/check.
- Start & run on load (ie. with boiling kettle) fortnightly.



### **OPERATION**

- Visually inspect prior to starting.
- Check & top up oil & fuel (prior to starting) if needed.
- Let generator warm up (approx. 2 min) before use.
- Run in well-ventilated outdoor area, under cover if possible.
- Run on level solid surface, not directly on dirt/sand.
- Do not let generator run out of fuel under load.
- Do not overload generator.
- Turn off fuel tap after use.

# 5 CYCLONE USE

- Wait until after cyclone passes completely before starting generator to avoid salt mist inundation in alternator.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Take care with extension leads to minimise trip hazards.
- Do not run generator in or near stagnant water.

• Avoid direct connect to main switchboard until potential hazards have been identified & resolved.

## **ALTERNATIVE POWER**

• Turn off solar array prior to starting generator.

• Generator Changeover Switch: Turn from Ergon/Main to Off. Start generator. Turn from Off to Generator.
